To: 2025 National Barrow Show Exhibitors:

Welcome back to Austin, Minnesota for the 79th National Barrow Show. This is always a great experience with countless breed improvers throughout the decades to improve our breeds. I have great confidence that 2025 will be another historic one.

Please find enclosed in this letter some essential things to make your trip less stressful and needed by our staff to coordinate a successful check in and show schedule. Please read carefully the material and especially those we have highlighted with a ****.

- **** 1) Health regulations. Enclosed. Must be tested negative for PRV and Brucellosis unless from a qualified free herd on or after August 8th.
- **** 2) Vaccinations, breeding stock
See rules
- **** 3) Two copies for each breeding stock consigned.
- **** 4) Poland China and Spotted entries **must** be stress identified on pedigree and **must** be either negative or stress carriers. No positives or potential positives allowed.
- 5) Underlines and breed character. Please make sure you are 100% confident that a minimum of six high quality teats/side and breed character has no issues. Call with questions.
- 6) All breeding stock must be farrowed December 1, 2024 or after to be eligible to exhibit. Market animals is January 1 and after.
- 7) Please see schedule of events for earliest and latest check in dates.
- **** 8) Please find enclosed a sheet to submit your ear notches and registration numbers of your **purebred** breeding stock to CPS on or before Wednesday, August 27. **Only Chester White, Hereford, Poland China, and Spotted** animals need to be submitted. Use one sheet for each breed and breeder. Either scan and email to cpspeoria@mindspring.com or fax to 309-691-0168. Make sure you include **both the ear notch and registration number.**

The CPS staff will be leaving the office Thursday, September 4th to begin travels to Minnesota. All pedigree work must be completed by this time.

1. EACH ANIMAL ENTERING THE MOWER COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS MUST BE LISTED ON AN OFFICIAL, INTERSTATE CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) ISSUED BY A LICENSED, ACCREDITED VETERINARIAN! A. Multiple animals may be listed on one original CVI. Two photocopies of the original CVI must be provided for each exhibitor.

2. CVIS MUST BE ISSUED ON OR AFTER FRIDAY, AUGUST 8, 2025 WITH THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- Name and address of consignor; consigned to the NBS®
- ALL SWINE being exhibited at the National Barrow Show® MUST be officially identified with an official, federally approved ear tag. The animal's ear tag ID must be listed on CVI. For more information on federally recognized ear tags, visit www.cpswine.com.
- Each animal shall be individually identified by ear notch.
- Health Status of animals, including dates of required tests and vaccinations must be listed.
- A premise ID number MUST be included on CVI.
- No Pigs with healed vesicles
- The cell phone number of your veterinarian who issued the CVI MUST be included on the CVI.
- ALL CVIs MUST CARRY THE FOLLOWING STATEMENTS: "FARM OR ORIGIN OF SWINE" :
 - ◆ Has not had pseudorabies or swine dysentery in the last 12 months
 - ◆ Have not been vaccinated for Pseudorabies
 - ◆ Swine has not been fed garbage, either raw or cooked
 - ◆ Has not had any signs or diagnosis of TGE or PEDV or Novel Swine Enteric Coronavirus Disease(s) (SECD) in the last 60 days
 - ◆ Is not under quarantine for any disease or condition
 - ◆ Has not had vesicular stomatitis diagnosed within 10 miles of farm or origin in the last 90 days

3. REQUIRED TESTS:

→ **PSEUDORABIES (PRV) TESTING:** ALL BREEDING AND MARKET ANIMALS ENTERED IN THE NBS® or Junior Classic MUST BE INDIVIDUALLY TESTED FOR PRV ON OR AFTER AUGUST 8, 2025 **UNLESS** animals come from a PRV-qualified herd.

- ◆ All official identification of animal (sex, ear tag, and ear notch) needs to be included on the pseudorabies test chart
- ◆ Animals must test PRV-negative with all results on the dated CVI
- ◆ The official PRV test chart must be provided along with your CVI
- ◆ Either the ELISA (gB ELISA), ALA, or S/N tests are acceptable. Differentiable ELISA (g1 ELISA) test will NOT be accepted
- ◆ If BREEDING SHOW ANIMAL or MARKET ANIMAL come from a PRV qualified herd, individual testing of each animal is not required.

In this case, the PRV qualification numbers must appear on the health certificate and the most recent quarterly herd test date (month, day and year) must be stated on health certificate

→ **BRUCELLOSIS TESTING:** ALL BREEDING AND MARKET ANIMALS entered in the NBS® or Junior Classic MUST be individually tested for brucellosis on or after August 8, 2025, **UNLESS** animals originate from a validated brucellosis free herd.

- ◆ Animals must test brucellosis negative with all results on the dated CVI.
- ◆ If the herd of origin is brucellosis validated, the validation numbers must appear on the CVI and the most recent quarterly herd test date (month, day, and year) must be stated on the CVI.

→ VACCINATIONS:

- ◆ All breeding swine coming to show in the **OPEN SHOW** MUST be vaccinated against leptospirosis (6-way) including bratislava and erysipelas.
 - The complete date of vaccination MUST be listed on the health certificate. Market animals should not be vaccinated
- ◆ It is strongly recommended that breeding animals are vaccinated for swine influenza.

In some instances, these requirements are in addition to the state of Minnesota regulations. However, they are necessary to meet other state requirements for purchasers of open show animals through sales as animals are re-consigned to new destinations.
