

2026 CPS Southwest Elite Weanling Sale and Sift Health Requirements:

Oklahoma Origin Animals (including deliveries and trailer sales):

- All consignors must have a federal premise ID
- Swine from within Oklahoma must have an official electronic 840 button tag (EID/RFID) and be ear notched
- Must be vaccinated for circo/myco

Out-of-State Origin Animals:

- All consignors must have a federal premise ID.
- Every animal, including deliveries and trailer sales, entering the Lincoln County Fairgrounds must be listed on an official interstate Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued by a licensed, accredited veterinarian. Loads with animals not listed on the CVI or not meeting the following requirements will not be unloaded and will be sent back to the farm of origin.
- Multiple animals may be listed on the same original CVI.
- All animals from outside Oklahoma must obtain a permit number. Only accredited veterinarians can obtain this permit number by calling the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture at 405.522.6141 M-F 8am-5pm or by visiting <https://ag.ok.gov/divisions/animal-industry-state-veterinarian/> and click on “Animal Movement and Importation”. If utilizing an **electronic Certificate of Veterinarian Inspection (eCVI)**, an import permit is **NOT** required as long as the requirements have been met and are listed on the certificate.
- ***CVIs must be issued on or after August 20, 2026. With the following information:***
 - o Name and Physical address of the consignor; consigned to CPS Southwest Elite, Lincoln County Fairgrounds, 1023 E 15th Place, Chandler, OK 74834. Ph 309.691.0151
 - o **All animals (including deliveries and trailer sales) MUST be officially identified with an USDA federally approved ear tag/official ID.**
 - o Ear notches and official ID for **each** animal must be listed on the CVI.
 - o **Premise ID** must be listed on the CVI.
 - o Dates of required tests and results must be listed on the CVI.
 - o Issuing veterinarians cell phone number must be listed on the CVI.
 - o CVI must contain the following statements:

The farm or origin of swine:

- Has not had pseudorabies or swine dysentery in the last 12 months
 - Has not had any clinical signs or diagnosis of TGE or PEDv in the last 60 days
 - Feeds no raw garbage and uses no PRV vaccine
 - Is not under quarantine for any disease condition
 - Has not had vesicular stomatitis diagnosed within 10 miles of farm or origin in the last 30 days
 - Swine have not originated from a premises known to be affected by SECD (Swine Enteric Coronavirus Disease) and have not been exposed to SECD in the past 30 days.
 - Have not been exposed to or vaccinated for pseudorabies.
 - All animals from outside of Oklahoma must be tested and found negative for brucellosis and pseudorabies on or after August 20, 2026 with test dates and results listed on CVI or originate from a V/Q herd with current test status and VQ herd number included on CVI
- All animals must be vaccinated for circo/myco
